

Chairman Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs and Paul Campbell.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

2013-53 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the minutes from the May 7, 2013 Special Election, May 20, 2013 Opening of Canvass and May 28, 2013 Official Canvass and Regular Monthly Meeting. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

2013-54 – Dave Lane made the motion to approve and pay the June bills. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

2013-55 – At 2:06 p.m. Rick Combs made the motion to go into Executive Session for the purpose to discuss pending litigation per Ohio Revised Code 121.22 (G) (3). Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

2013-56 – At 2:15 p.m. Rick Combs made the motion to come out of Executive Session. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

The action taken by the Board was the Board had a report from Mary Lynne Birck (Legal Representation) regarding settlement in the Hardin vs. Clermont County Board of Elections case.

2013-57 – Dave Lane made the motion to accept the settlement as presented by Mary Lynne Birck. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

DIRECTOR’S REPORT:

Director Miller explained that every two years we are required to complete the NCOA (National Change of Address) mailing. These are voters that changed their address with the Post Office but not with our office. The Supplemental List, is the list of voters that did not vote in the last two years. The total number of voters in this mailing is 6,395, we had 25,003 in 2011. The cards must be mailed by June 30; our cards will be mailed June 21. (NCOA cards – 4,771 and Supplemental cards – 1,624 = 6,395 total cards)

Judy gave the Board the employee evaluations and the Board reviewed them. Dave stated that we were fortunate to have the group of people that we have here. Judy added that we have had some very successful elections, and that is thanks to the tremendous employees of this office. Rick would have liked to see what the employees could improve upon. Paul's opinion was that the evaluation form shows where they could improve.

Re-Precincting Project:

Judy discussed the re-precincting project, and what was involved in combining or dividing the 200 precincts. She had written descriptions and maps of each township to show and explain the new precinct lines. We have to work within streets, roads and census blocks. She reminded them that the precinct cannot have more than 1400 voters. While reviewing Pierce Township Judy mentioned that in Pierce B we will be required to obtain a Waiver from the Secretary of State. We can justify why we need to run the lines the way they need to be run. We are going to move UN-B and UN-Y from Brantner Elementary School to a new location, the All Saints Lutheran Church, 445 Craig Road.

2013-58 – Dave Lane made the motion to approve the proposed precinct changes as presented by the Director and Deputy Director and request the Waiver for Pierce Township B from the Secretary of State. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

Judy stated that the letters regarding the precinct changes will begin being mailed out in July. She added that there will be some polling location changes involved with the re-precincting project.

Dave Lane left the meeting at 3:30 p.m.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Deputy Director Keeley reported that due to the agenda change for the SOS Summer Conference, those staff members attending will now be going to Columbus on Tuesday instead of Wednesday. There was also an agenda change for the IACREOT Conference. Judy and Mike will be at the conference from June 28 thru July 2.



CLERMONT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Proposed Re-Precincting – June 2013

All Voter numbers include Active and Inactive Totals.
Maps have been created for every proposal.

Batavia Township:

1) Split Precinct Batavia Twp. K (1,412 Voters) - (Creating Additional Precinct – Batavia Twp N)

- Western Portion to remain as Batavia Twp K and will then contain (708 Voters)
- Eastern Portion will be the New Precinct designated as “Batavia Twp N” and will contain (704 Voters)
 - Divide Batavia Twp. K using Laub Rd. as the division line until its ending & then using the census block line that connects Laub Rd. & Covedale Ln. & runs with Covedale Ln. until it reaches precinct
 - School District – Both Precincts located in West Clermont LSD
 - Polling Location: No Change - (Batavia Twp. Hall)

2) Moved 2 Portions from Batavia Twp. B – (1,386 Voters) – Reducing Precinct to 657 Total Voters

- Moved 512 Voters from Batavia Twp B to Batavia Twp I – (386 Voters) -
New Total Voters in Batavia Twp I = 898 Voters
- Moved 218 Voters from Batavia Twp B (WC Split) and moved to Batavia Twp L (596 Voters) -
New Total Voters in Batavia Twp L = 814 Voters - (alleviates split in Batavia B of West Clermont School Dist.)

Proposal: Divide Batavia Twp. B into two portions starting at the southern point of Taylor Rd & then following Taylor Rd until it intersects with Armstrong Blvd. The division line will head north on Armstrong Blvd until it hits Old State Route 74. Everything east of this line will combine with Batavia Twp. I, which will now contain 898 Voters. The new Batavia Twp. B will have another alteration. It is currently a split precinct because of the West Clermont portion on the southernmost tip. That split portion contains 218 Voters, it will now become a part of Batavia Twp. L. The remainder of Batavia Twp. B will now have 657 Voters & Batavia Twp. L will have a new total of 814 Voters.

- School District: Merged Voters from Batavia Twp. B to Batavia Twp. I – Batavia LSD
- Polling Location: Merged voters only from Batavia Twp. B to Batavia Twp I will move from Batavia Twp Hall to the Batavia Middle School
- School District: Merged voters from Batavia Twp B to Batavia Twp L – Both West Clermont LSD
- Polling Location: Merged voters from Batavia Twp. B to Batavia Twp. L will move from Batavia Twp Hall to Holly Hill Elementary (since these voters live in West Clermont LSD)

3) Move portion from Batavia Township G- (1,227 Voters) – Reducing Precinct to 880 Voters

- Move 347 Voters from Batavia Twp G to Batavia Twp. F (544 Voters) = 891 Voters

Proposal: Divide precinct & merge the western portion into Batavia Twp. F. Begin the division line where Mt. Holly Rd starts off 125 until it meets Chapel Rd. Take a right on Chapel Rd then a left on 222 until Batavia Twp. C precinct line. This division will leave Batavia Twp. G with approximately 880 Voters & Batavia Twp. F with approximately 891 Voters.

- School District - West Clermont LSD
- Polling Location: No Change - (Holly Hill Elementary School Gym)

Batavia Village:

- 1) Combine Batavia Village A (366 Voters), Batavia Village B (291 Voters) & Batavia Village C (395 Voters) = 1,062 Total Voters
(Eliminated 2 Precincts: BAV-B and BAV-C)

- School District: Batavia LSD
- Polling Location: No change – (Batavia Middle School Gym)

Franklin Township:

- 1) Combine Precinct Franklin Twp. A (373 Voters) & Franklin Twp. C (476 Voters) = 849 Total Voters
(Eliminated Franklin Twp C)

- School District: Felicity-Franklin & Bethel-Tate (28 Voters).
- Polling Location: No Change - (Felicity-Franklin High School Gym)

Goshen Township:

- 1) Combine Precincts Goshen Twp. A (352 Voters) & Goshen Twp. H (494 Voters) = 846 Total Voters
(Eliminated GN-H)

- School District – Both Goshen LSD
- Polling Location: No Change - (Goshen High School Gym)

**2) Combine Precincts Goshen Twp. B (663 Voters) & Goshen Twp. C (300 Voters) = 963 Total Voters.
(Eliminated GN-C)**

- School District – Both Goshen LSD
- Polling Location: No Change - (Goshen High School Gym)

Miami Township:

1) Precinct Miami Twp. Z - (1,505 Voters) – Reducing Precinct to 1,219 Total Voters

- **Merge a portion of Miami Twp. Z (286 Voters) into Miami Twp. N1N (852 Voters) = 1,138 Voters**

Proposal: Move a portion of Miami Twp. Z into Miami Twp. N1N. Start the division line where Paxton-Guinea Rd meets Miami Twp. N1N & follows south until it hits Mueller Lakes Ln, then heads west until Mueller Lakes Ln ends on Paul Vista Dr. The division line then heads west & immediately turns south on Paxton Woods Dr. which curves southward until it meets up again with Paxton Guinea Rd, which finally heads west & stops at Miami Twp. K1K. This portion will add 286 Voters to Miami Twp. N1N for a total of approximately 1,138 Voters & reduce Miami Twp. Z to approximately 1,219 Voters.

- School District – Both Loveland Exempt School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Loveland Early Childhood Center)

2) Precinct Miami Twp. Y – (1,385 Voters) - Reducing Precinct to 1,121 Total Voters

- **Merge a portion of Miami Twp. Y (264 Voters) into Miami Twp. L1L (585 Voters) = 849 Voters**

Proposal: Move a portion of Miami Twp. Y to Miami Twp. L1L. Start the division line where Miami Woods Dr. first enters Miami Y until it intersects with Ridgewood Dr. & then heads northwest until it reaches Trailwoods Dr. then south until it intersects with Cedar Rd. The line will then head northeast until Cedar Rd touches the Loveland City B precinct boundary line. Everything in Miami Twp. Y west of this line will now be Miami Twp. L1L. This division will provide a balance between the two precincts which will add 264 Voters to Miami Twp. L1L for a total of approximately 849 Voters. Miami Twp. Y will no longer be approaching the limit with this reduction to approximately 1,121 Voters.

- School District – Both Loveland Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - (St. James Orthodox Church) – New Location
(* Moving "Y" from McCormick Elem (which is in Milford School Dist)
and "L1L" from Epworth VFW due to ADA non-compliance)

3) Precinct Miami Twp. F1F – (1,282 Voters) – Reducing to 963 Total Voters

- **Merge a portion of Miami Twp. F1F (319 Voters) into Miami Twp. H1H (519 Voters) = 838 Voters**

Proposal: Move a portion of Miami Twp. F1F into Miami Twp. H1H to balance neighboring precincts. The division line will begin where East Glen Echo Ln intersects with Branch Hill Guinea Rd then follows East Glen Echo Ln until it reaches the Spires Dr. intersection, then heads north until Spire Dr. ends at Deerhaven Ln.

The line follows Deerhaven Ln. until it connects with Deerhaven Ct. then heads northwest for 600 ft. The precinct boundary line then cuts northeast at a census block line that runs into the precinct boundary for Miami Twp. P1P. The division will add approximately 319 to Miami Twp. H1H for a new total of 838. Miami Twp. F1F will decrease its total to a more manageable 963.

- School District – Both Milford Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - No Change - Boyd E. Smith Elementary School

4) Combine Precinct Miami Twp. A (607 Voters) & Miami Twp. B (505 Voters) = 1,112 Total Voters (Eliminate MI-B)

- School District – Both Loveland Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - (St. James Orthodox Church) – **New Location**
(*Moving “A” from Epworth VFW and “B” from the Mosaic Church)

5) Combine Precinct Miami Twp. J1J (353 Voters) & Miami Twp. K (686 Voters) = 1,039 Total Voters (Eliminate MI-J1J)

- School District – Both Milford Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - No Change - Faith Evangelical Church

6) Combine Precinct Miami Twp. E1E (609 Voters) & Miami Twp. T (355 Voters) = 964 Total Voters (Eliminate MI-E1E)

- School District – Both Milford Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - No Change - Eastside Christian Church

7) Combine Precinct Miami Twp. I (435 Voters) & Miami Twp. W (535 Voters) = 970 Total Voters (Eliminate MI-W)

- School District – Both Milford Exempt School District
- Polling Location: - No Change - Trinity United Methodist Church

8) Combine Precinct Miami Twp. I1I (325 Voters) & Miami Twp. X (763 Voters) = 1,088 Total Voters (Eliminate MI- I1I)

- 1) Combine Precinct Monroe Twp. H (224 Voters) & Monroe Twp. A (436 Voters) = 660 Total Voters

- 2) Combine Precinct Monroe Twp. G (517 Voters) & Monroe Twp. B (411 Voters) = 928 Total Voters
(Eliminate ME-G)**

- Polling Location: No Change - (Monroe Township Building)

- 3) Combine Precinct Monroe Twp. J (438 Voters) & Monroe Twp. D (342 Voters) = 780 Total Voters
(Eliminate ME-J)**

- Polling Location: No Change - (Monroe Elementary School)

- 4) Combine Precinct Monroe Twp. F (436 Voters) & Monroe Twp. C (400 Voters) = 836 Total Voters
(Eliminate ME-F)**

- School District – Both New Richmond Exempt School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Monroe Elementary School)

New Richmond Village:

- 1) Combine Precinct New Richmond Village B (431 Voters) & New Richmond Village C (551 Voters) = 982 Total Voters (Leaving NR-A as is: 732 Voters)
(Eliminate NR-C)

- School District – Both New Richmond Exempt School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (New Richmond Community Building)

Pierce Township:

Precinct Pierce B- 1,327 Voters (Voters concerns due to long lines) – Reducing to 632
Creating Additional Precinct – “Pierce M”

- Western Portion will remain as Pierce B and will contain (632 Voters)
- Northeastern Portion will be New Precinct designated as “Pierce M” and contain (695 Voters)

Option 1/Preferred- (East/West) - Divide precinct into two new precincts using Nine Mile Creek as the divider. This would create two separate precincts. That portion east of Nine Mile Creek would contain approximately 695 Voters & the western portion would contain 632 Voters.

Remarks: The new section *east* of Nine Mile Creek contains the Legendary Run subdivision. There is a Clubhouse in this subdivision that could be used as a polling location. We would not look to merge this precinct portion with any other area at this time because it is not logistically feasible & there is a high Voter turnout in this area.

With regards to the *western* section containing 632 Voters, it is likewise not logistically feasible to merge with another precinct & this would also allow for Voter growth. While Pierce Elementary School presently serves as the polling location for Pierce B, after the split, the western portion would continue to vote at the Locust Corner Elementary School (even though it is located within the precinct boundaries of the eastern section).

Contingency: This division would create a split of a census block which would require a Waiver from the Secretary of State

Option 2- (North/South)- Divide the precinct into two sections along Locust Corner Rd. The section north of Locust Corner Rd would contain approximately 1,066 Voters & the southern portion would contain approximately 261 Voters. The only precinct that the southern portion could be merged with is precinct Pierce E which presently contains 926 Voters for a total of 1,187 Voters.

Remarks: Should the split be made North/South as described in Option 2, the polling location for the southern portion would have to be moved to the Pierce Township Hall.

Contingency: There would be no census blocks broken but the northern section of the precinct containing the Legendary Run subdivision would still encompass 1,066 voters which would not solve the problem we are trying to address.

2) Combine Precinct Pierce Twp A (500 Voters) & Pierce Twp L (361 Voters) + Portion of J (3 Voters) = 864 (Eliminate PE-L)

➤ **Then merge 3 Voters in Pierce J (NR School Dist) into the combined Precinct of A&L**
(Remained of PE-J are in West Clermont LSD and will no longer be a Split Precinct)

- School District – Pierce A – West Clermont LSD & New Richmond SD
(Pierce L Portion in – West Clermont LSD)
(Pierce J – New Richmond SD)
- Polling Location: A & L- No Change - (Locust Corner Elementary)
J (Moving from Merwin Elem to Locust Corner Elem)

Proposal: Combine precincts Pierce A & L due to low number of voters in each. Both precincts vote at the same polling location of Locust Corner Elementary & currently share Hopper Hill Rd as a common boundary. The merger would produce a single precinct that contains 861 Voters. This would be more cost effective in reducing the number of precincts in the county.

Part 2: Pierce A & its eastern neighboring county Pierce J both have split school districts due to a small stretch of New Richmond School District in between them. Pierce A will take the New Richmond territory that Pierce J holds, which will remove the split from Pierce J & reduce confusion for Voters. As a result, three Voters will be added to Pierce A for a new total of approximately 864 Voters.

3) Combine Precinct Pierce Twp. D (697 Voters) & Pierce Twp. H (279 Voters) = 976 (Eliminate PE-H)

- School District – PE-D is West Clermont LSD (689) & New Richmond Ex School District (8)
PE-H is West Clermont LSD (279)
- Polling Location: No Change - (Amelia Elem School)

4) Merge the Eastern Portion of Pierce Twp F (293 Voters) with Pierce K (672) = 965 Total Voters (Eliminate Pierce F) - (Keeping K)

- School District – Both West Clermont LSD
- Polling Location – No Changes (Merwin Elem)

5) Merge Western Portion of Pierce Twp. F (182 Voters) into Pierce Twp. G (679 Voters) = 861 total Voters (Keeping G)

- School District – Both West Clermont LSD
- Polling Location – No Changes (Merwin Elem)

Proposal: Consolidate northern Pierce Township & eliminate precinct Pierce F by dividing Pierce F in half at Merwin Ten Mile Rd & merging each of the two halves into the neighboring precincts of G & K respectively. All three of these precincts currently use the same polling location of Merwin Elementary School. This would eliminate one precinct & result in Pierce G having approximately 861 Voters & Pierce K having approximately 965 voters.

Stonelick Township:

**1) Combine Precinct Stonelick Twp. D (401 Voters) & Stonelick Twp. G (385 Voters) = 786 Total Voters
(Eliminate SK-G)**

- School District – Both Clermont Northeastern School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Clermont County Fairgrounds)

**2) Combine Precinct Stonelick Twp. F (562 Voters) & Stonelick Twp. A (344 Voters) = 906 Total Voters
(Eliminate SK-F)**

- School District – Both Clermont Northeastern School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Clermont County Fairgrounds)

Tate Township:

**1) Combine Precinct Tate Twp. D (531 Voters) & Tate Twp. G (487 Voters) and Merge New Richmond SD portion of Tate H together = 1,020 Total Voters
(Eliminate TE-G)**

- Since Tate H is a precinct with a Split School District that only has 2 Voters – we will move the New Richmond portion of Tate H to Tate D (which is already a split precinct) and alleviate a split precinct.
- School District: Tate Twp. D – Bethel-Tate School District & New Richmond Ex Village SD
- (School District: Tate Twp. G - Bethel-Tate School District)
- Polling Location: No Change - (Bethel-Tate Middle School)
(*The 2 Voters from Tate H will move from the Bethel Community Center to the Bethel Community Center – which is a shorter driving distance.)

**2) Combine Precinct Tate Twp. A (578 Voters) & Tate Twp. E (341 Voters) = 919 Total Voters
(Eliminate Tate E)**

- School District – Both Bethel-Tate School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Bethel-Tate Middle School)

**3) Combine Precinct Tate Twp. B (447 Voters) & Tate Twp. I (439 Voters) = 886 Total Voters
(Eliminate Tate I)**

- School District – Both Bethel-Tate School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Bethel-Tate Middle School)

**4) Combine Precinct Tate Twp. C (465 Voters) & Tate Twp. F (320 Voters) = 785 Total Voters
(Eliminate C)**

- School District – Tate Twp. C - Bethel-Tate School District
- School District - Tate Twp. F (split) – Bethel-Tate School District & Felicity-Franklin LSD
- Polling Location: Tate F will remain at the Bethel Middle School & Tate C will move from the Bethel Community Center to the Bethel Middle School.

Bethel Village:

1) Bethel Village A - Incorporate a small portion of Bethel Village B & C (using State Route 125 as a clear divider in Bethel Village A.

Bethel Village A (658 Voters) and will incorporate 64 total from B&C = (722 Voters)

- School District – Both Bethel-Tate School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Bethel-Tate Middle School)

**2) Combine Precinct Bethel Village B (340 Voters) & Bethel Village C (609 Voters) = 950 Total Voters
(Eliminate Bethel Village C)**

- School District – Both Bethel-Tate School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (Bethel-Tate Middle School)

Union Township:

1) Precinct Union D – (1,131 Voters) – Moving 294 Voters to Union L1L - Reducing “D” Precinct to 837

2) Union L1L (495 Voters) + Portion of Union D (294 Voters) + a Portion of Union A (11 Voters – West Clermont LSD) + Entire Precinct of Union G1G (268 Voters) = 1,068 Total Voters (Alleviating a 3 way split in A) (Eliminating Union G1G)

- School District – All West Clermont LSD
- Polling Place – No Change for D & L1L
G1G moving from Willowville Elem to 1st Baptist Church of Glen Este

Proposal: Divide Union D into two parts by using Tealtown Rd as the division line. Combine the northern half of D with precincts Union Twp. L1L (495 Voters) & Union Twp. G1G (268 Voters). Also combine the part of Union A that contains the West Clermont split for an additional 11 Voters. The combination will create one new precinct that contains 1,068 Voters & the southern half of Union D will be left with 837 Voters.

3) Precinct Union H - (1,283 Voters) – Reducing to 936 Total Voters

➤ Move portion of H (347 Voters) to Union M1M (497 Voters) = 844 Total Voters

Proposal: Cut a portion of Union H off starting at Newberry Dr & continuing along Eastwood Dr until it connects with Shayler Rd at the Union E precinct boundary line. This portion, which has 347 Voters, is to be moved to Union M1M which shares a boundary along State Route 32. After the division, Union H will have 936 Voters & Union M1M will have 844 Voters. Both precincts will continue to go to their current Polling Location at First Baptist Church.

- School District – Both West Clermont School District
- Polling Location: No Change - (1st Baptist Church of Glen Este)

4) Precinct Union R1R- (1,276 Voters) – Reducing to 882 Total Voters

➤ Move portion of R1R (394 Voters) to Union T (628 Voters) = 1,022 Total Voters

Proposal: Move a portion of Union R1R to Union T to balance neighboring precincts. The division line will be Shayler Rd. The southern portion of Union R1R below Shayler Rd will move to Union T, which will move 394 Voters. This will leave R1R with approximately 882 & T with approximately 1,022 Voters.

Remarks: The Voters in the portion of R1R being moved will no longer go to the Union Township Civic Center for their polling location, instead they will go to Withamsville Church.

Altering Precinct Boundaries to Coincide with School Districts- There are currently four precincts in Washington Township. Three of the four contain at least two school districts that create a “split precinct”. This causes confusion for poll workers & voters. This proposal will align the precinct boundaries with the school district lines to reduce the number of splits & balance the number of voters in each precinct.

The New Richmond School District line will be the division line for the western portion of Washington Township. This will be the new Washington B boundary line, & due to a small number of Voters in Moscow Village (183) it will become a part of Washington B as a split with the name WN-B.NRM. The new Washington B will contain approximately 502 Voters.

The current Washington C will receive the portion of Felicity-Franklin School district that was previously a part of Washington B. This will add a small number of Voters & the new Washington C will contain approximately 360 Voters. The Neville Village split in this precinct will now be known as WN-C.FFN.

Washington A currently is a three way split which contains New Richmond, Felicity & Bethel Tate school districts. The western portion of Washington A where the New Richmond school district line runs from bottom to top is to be split off & will be a part of the new Washington B. The rest will remain as is, which will reduce the splits in this precinct from three to two & reduce the number of Voters to approximately 493.
