

**Start of Official Canvass for the  
November 5, 2013 General Election**

**November 18, 2013 at 9:00 a.m.**

Chairman Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 9:07 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs, and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director, and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**OTHER ATTENDEES:** None

**PUBLIC TEST DECK:**

Dave and Rick observed the Test Deck being run thru the 650 scanner. Tim read the results from the Control Sheet while Dave compared them to the newly run test deck and found them to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

**2013-114** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the results of the Test Deck. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**ABSENTEE BALLOTS:**

Director Miller reviewed the breakdown of the Absentee Ballots with the Board.

**VALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

7 – Postmarked before November 5, 2013 (Election Day) and received within the 10 day period

**2013-115** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the 7 additional Valid Absentees and add them to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**INVALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

25 – Postmarked November 5, 2013 (Election Day) or after

43 – Refused by nursing home voters-requested by not voted

7 – No Stub attached

3 – Postmark Date to be determined by the Board

**2013-116** – Rick Combs made the motion to reject and not count the 80 absentee ballots that the staff has determined to be invalid. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**PROVISIONAL BALLOTS:**

Director Miller reviewed the Provisional Ballots with the Board.

She explained that one voter was challenged at the polls by the presiding judge. The voter filled out the form stating that he did live at that address and did show a driver's license with the correct address.

**2013-117** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the ballot (provisional) of Craig Rigdon that was challenged at the polls and add it to the regular count. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

### **INVALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

- 8 – did not sign the front of the provisional envelope
- 2 – printed name not on provisional envelope
- 2 – new address in another county
- 17 – voted wrong church/wrong pew – wrong polling location/wrong precinct

**2013-118** – Paul Campbell made the motion to reject the Provisional Ballots that should not be counted. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

### **VALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

- 2 – provisional envelope completed-signed front/not registration card
- 19 – voted right church/wrong pew – right polling location/wrong precinct
- 416 – appear to be valid – no visible problems

**2013-119** – Dave Lane made the motion to accept the 437 valid Provisional Ballots and to duplicate those which are necessary to duplicate as identified by the staff and add them to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**2013-120** – Rick Combs made the motion to instruct the Office Staff to proceed with the Official Canvass per Board Policy as in the Election Administration Plan. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

### **APPROVAL OF BILLS:**

**2013-121** – Dave Lane made the motion to accept and pay the bills. Upon discussion Rick inquired about the entry for janitorial payroll. Judy and Mike explained that it is for the set-up and take-down of equipment for each precinct within the polling locations. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Paul brought to the Board's attention that he went to the Bethel Middle School polling location on Election Day. He stated that the access to the building was very poor, the entrance was in the back and there were no flags out. The handicap situation was lacking. He said there was sign in the front that said for voters to go to the rear. Mike said he will revisit that situation. Paul added that one of the poll workers was very disgruntled because of the situation (bad card in the M100). Paul stated that Mark Blackburn (rover) arrived and took care of the situation. Paul added that if a card needs to go to the polls we need to make sure there is a rover to insert them. Judy advised that Mark Blackburn (rover) was aware of the situation and had been dispatched to Bethel, knowing that the new M100 Card was being delivered.

At 11:32 a.m. the Chairman stated that the Board will stand Recess and will reconvene on November 26, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. to Certify the November General Election and hold the Regular Monthly Board Meeting.

**Board Reconvenes**  
**Certification and Regular Meeting**  
**November 26, 2013, 10:00 a.m.**

The Board Reconvened and was back in Session on November 26, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs, and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director, and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**OTHER ATTENDEES:** Bob Hausermann, Candidate for Goshen Township Trustee

**PUBLIC TEST DECK:**

Dave and Rick observed the Test Deck being run thru the 650 scanner. Tim read the results from the Control Sheet while Dave compared them to the newly run test deck and found them to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

**2013-122** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the results of the Test Deck. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**CERTIFICATION OF THE NOVEMBER 5, 2013 GENERAL ELECTION:**

Director Miller stated that we also need, per the Directive for approval of the Certified Official Results, a copy of the computer tally sheets of the Official Count and a form that the Board must sign stating they approve of the Official Results.

**2013-123** – Rick Combs made the motion to Certify the Results of the November 5, 2013 General Election and forward them to the Secretary of State. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**Recounts:**

Director Miller explained that there was one race that qualified for an Automatic Recount- Wayne Township Trustees, 2 to be elected. Harold Grosnickle is the declared winner and the recount is between Warren Walker (332) and Teresa Hinnars (326). The entire race will be recounted. It appears that overlapping races of Loveland City Council and Loveland City Local Schools Board Members will qualify for a recount after we report our Certified results to Hamilton County.

**2013-124** – Dave Lane made the motion to set the date of the Automatic Recounts for December 5, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**2013-125** – Rick Combs made the motion to approve the minutes from the October 24, 2013 Regular Board Meeting. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS:**

**2013-126** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept and pay the November 26, 2013 bills. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Judy advised the Board that Mr. Hauserman had inquired about a paid recount in his race for Goshen Township Trustee since it did not qualify for an automatic recount. He has until Monday, December 2, 2013 to let us know by written notice and which precincts he wants counted. The cost, per SOS Advisory 2013-01, is a deposit of \$55 per precinct and the Board would determine what the cost is to hold the recount and what money if any would be returned to Mr. Hausermann.

**COMMUNICATIONS:**

**Annexation:**

Judy advised the Board that Denise E. Large petitioned the Village of Batavia to bring her property (4160 Old S. Riverside, Batavia Ohio 45103, 0.94235 acres) into the Village. It was approved by the Commissioners and the Village of Batavia, effective November 4, 2013.

**2013-127** – Rick Combs made the motion to amend the records and change the address of 4160 Old S. Riverside Drive, Batavia, Ohio 45103 from Batavia Township “C” to Batavia Village “A” per Batavia Village Ordinance 1290-13, as recommended by the County Commissioners. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**Letter from County Commissioners:**

The Board received a letter dated November 19, 2013 regarding Health Care Coverage for Board Members effective January 1, 2015 from the County Commissioners. Tim discussed the points of the letter and asked that a letter be drafted, by the Director, for an opinion from Legal Counsel.

**2013-128** – Rick Combs made the motion to seek legal opinion regarding the letter received from the Board of County Commissioners regarding Board Members Health Insurance. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon discussion Rick asked that the Chairman review the letter after it is drafted. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Judy reviewed the 2013 Budget with the Board. She stated that we will give back approximately \$91,000 at the end of the year. She stated that Bonnie Carlier is considering retiring in May 2014. We need to start training someone early for her position. There is a possibility that Mike could retire next year as well. Rick asked if we have a Republican part-time person yet. Mike stated we had not found one yet and Judy added that she will advertise for the position in January.

Mike added that the staff has not had a raise for a while. Mike asked that raises be put in the budget, but it has evidently been turned down. He would like the Board to consider giving each staff member a year-

end bonus before we turn back the money. Tim advised he is not in favor of year-end bonuses. He further advised that he knows we will have to go back and ask for any money for raises. Judy added without an IT person in the office the staff has had to perform many of those duties. The Board discussed if any other county offices were receiving bonuses or raises. Dave wanted to go on record as to explore some way to increase the compensation of the staff; he thinks they are worth it and it doesn't matter if we have the electronic poll books if we don't have an intelligent staff to manage them. Paul added that it is justified that this staff be compensated for doing more with less and should be compensated for the extra work load that is put on them. He thinks this Board is justified with some type of increase for our employees. Tim suggested drafting a letter to the Commissioners expressing our thoughts and our Board has gone out of our way in saving money. Judy will draft a letter.

Judy advised the Board that Betsy Hart-Director of the Clinton County BOE, contacted her before the election stating that 4 of their M100's and stands fell off of their trucks, damaging the equipment. Their spare M100's were used or down and they were desperate for M-100 election equipment. Since we have 34 spares with the downsizing of the precincts we loaned 4 M-100's (with stands) to the Clinton County Board of Elections and they came down and picked up the equipment. Dan Shebesta was in already in Clinton County and was able to program the equipment. They would like to borrow the equipment until December 2014 because of budget issues. Judy has since found out that there is a form to fill out when equipment is transferred to another county that was purchased with HAVA money. Mike has the serial numbers of the equipment and all required information for the form.

**2013-129** – Rick Combs made the motion to loan four (4) M100's to Clinton County from November 4, 2013 thru December 31, 2014 (thru Certification of Election). Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon discussion Dave inquired about the equipment coming back in working condition. Judy stated that we are already paying for the M100's to be serviced (per contract agreement with ES&S) and Dan Shebesta can service them in Clinton County. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**DEPUTY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Deputy Director Keeley discussed the Legislative Update of Senate Bill 109 with the Board. He went over some of the key topics; Board Members Terms in odd number years, Observers, Electronic Poll Books, Ballot Terminology, and Official Oversight of Board of Elections.




